Each year for the past 65 years, "Jamboree" has raised funds for need-based college scholarships for graduating RHS seniors by presenting an original musical revue.

In 2011 the Jamboree Scholarship Fund awarded 23 scholarships to RHS graduating seniors. In the past decade, the Fund has distributed over \$800,000 in scholarships to over 150 graduating seniors.

Every parent or guardian of a RHS student is invited to participate in this very worthy cause. The number of participants is not restricted. In fact, the more participants there are, the more money raised and the more fun and fulfillment that can be shared!

All year long producers, directors and committees are hard at work fund raising, choosing the show's theme, recruiting musicians, developing scenes, selecting and arranging music and doing all of the advance work to prepare for the show. Whatever your talents, Jamboree has a place for you. Each year more than 125 RHS parents and guardians contribute by singing, dancing, acting, performing in the band, designing and making costumes, building sets, managing set changes and being back-stage heroes.
